



He is the recipient of the GLADD Media Award, the Southern California Psychotherapy Association Courage in Filmmaking Award, the People For the American Way Defending Freedom Citation, the PFLAG Oscar Wilde Award, the MECLA Humanitarian Award, the FMPTA Crystal Reel Award, the UCF Cinematic Legacy Award, the WGA Gay Groundbreakers Citation, the Outfest Gay Pioneer Award for Courage and Artistry, and the Outfest Thom/Tom Award for Distinguished Service to the LGBTQ Community. He has been honored by the Berlin, Seattle, Florida, Asheville, Santa Barbara, Gay Orlando, Montreal, and Q2 Film Festivals, the American Cinemateque, the Florida Queer Arts Council, the Orlando Gay and Lesbian Center, Cal State Northridge, the University of Nebraska, and the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. He is highlighted in WHO'S WHO IN AMERICA, is an onscreen commentator in THE CELLULOID CLOSET, is profiled in MAKING HISTORY: THE STRUGGLE FOR GAY AND LESBIAN EQUAL RIGHTS, and was named by The Advocate as one of the most influential gay artists in America. In addition to his writing, Sandler currently teaches Screenwriting and Film History at UCF.
